Hair & Jewellery Policy

Dear Parents,

Hair

In keeping with Al Salam Policy regarding Student Dress Code:

For Boys:

- 1. Keep the hair neat and tidy and not to cover the face
- 2. Hairstyles like mohawks, mullets, dreadlocks etc. are not allowed
- 3. Natural hair color or highlights are allowed

For Girls:

- 1. If hair is shoulder length or longer, it should be tied back neatly
- 2. Keep the hair neat and tidy and not to cover the face
- 3. Natural hair color or highlights are allowed
 - **♦** No makeup or nail varnish is allowed for students.

We would appreciate your assistance toward ensuring that children's hair is in compliance with the school policy.

Jewellery

The wearing of jewellery is discouraged with the exception of:

- A watch
- One pair of stud-type earrings in the ear lobe (for girls).
- Minimal jewellery is permitted for students in Secondary.

Parents can help by ensuring that school guidance on jewellery is adhered to.

For safety reasons, we would like to remind parents and students that wearing of jewellery within school can be hazardous due to the fact that jewellery can become caught leading to injury, in particular when the student is involved in sports and playtime activities.

Failure to abide by the dress code will result in parents being called and if repeated may be required to take their child/children or bring the clothing required to school
